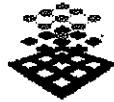

**COMMENTS:**

- Well-presented, comprehensive, and useful planning document.
- Unclear how the *Proximity to Schools* component of the *Overall Hazard* score ranking was factored into the score computation.
- The *Legal Restrictions*, *Cost*, *Environmental Impact*, and *Economic Impact* categories all were assigned the weighting factor of 0.0 giving the impression that these categories have little (or “Zero”) effect on the prioritization process. This is inconsistent with the scoring of two of these categories, *Cost & Legal Restrictions*, which had some high scores for the AOCs with several 80s and 90s.
- Recognize that the MP is both an iterative and living document and should be revisited every 6 months to determine whether site conditions and/or activities should be cause for re-scoring some or all of the AOCs. Especially, in the case where any potential new AOCs are identified and need to be added to the prioritization process.
