REVIEW COMMENTS FROM SITE INSPECTION REPORT – ADDENDUM 1 HOT SPOT REMOVAL

- The *Hot Spot* removal activities documented in the SI Addendum 1 Report appeared to be well documented, concise, and straightforward. Given the extent of comprehensive, on-site sample screening and follow-up analytical work, we concur with the conclusions presented. We recommend that the RAB accept the conclusions as presented in the SI Addendum 1 Report.
- The conclusions presented in Section A.7 include the statement (or variations thereof), “The site was restored to the condition of the surrounding area to the extent practical.” What did the restoration include? Did this include ground leveling (or backfilling) and re-seeding?

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- The terminology *Hot Spot* has a connotation associated with radioactivity levels. This Addendum 1 Report clearly doesn't deal with any radioactive samples but because there have been elevated levels of radioactivity at the site due to depleted Uranium residues, this term may be a potential source of confusion for some readers of the report.
