## **LOWRY TRAINING ANNEX**

### ***Navy Report***

*(presentation attached)*

Mr. Ed Lohr presented a summary and overview of the Denver Research Institute (DRI) Site and Ammo Storage Areas located within the Lowry Training Annex. The presentation included a summary of the soil sample results, a discussion of geophysical study results, and project schedule for the sites. The ammo storage area is complete, but the DRI site is still waiting for additional funding. All environmental data from the ammo storage area will be placed in the Aurora Public Library for viewing.

#### ***Question/Answer***

Why is it necessary to haul uncontaminated soil off-site?

Environmental Protection Agency guidelines state that any soil excavated must be removed. It is also faster and less expensive to remove the soil from the site.

### ***Air Force Report***

Mr. Dennis Guadarrama reported that the Air Force, as a responsible party for the Lowry Training Annex, is seeking funding for the project. Mr. Guadarrama stated that money is available, but Department of Defense approval is still pending. The Air Force will begin contracting as soon as the funds are available.

### ***Settlement Agreement and Field Work Update***

Mr. Jerry Hodgson presented a summary/update of the FLBGR project status. The presentation included a summary of current activities and a summary of activities completed to date.
