

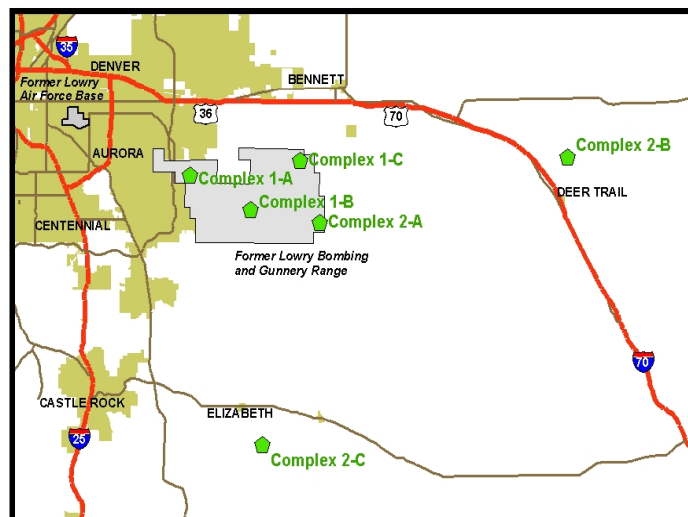

## Bennett ANG History

- Lowry Bombing and Gunnery Range (1940-1958)
- Titan I Missile Complex 2-A (1958-1965)
- Determination of Excess (1974)
- Accountability Assigned to Army (1978)
- 25 Year Lease to Colorado Army Reserve National Guard (1983)
- Identified for Disposal on the Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC) I (1988)



## Timeline of BRAC Disposal Process

- **National Environmental Policy Act Documentation**
  - Prepare Supplemental Environmental Assessment (EA) to the EA and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) completed in 1990 – June 2004
  - Memorandum of Agreement between the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) and Army – March 2004
  - Complete Historic American Engineering Record (HAER) Documentation – Fall 2004
- **Environmental Requirements**
  - Investigative Actions – Completed Fall 2003
  - Draft Engineering Evaluation/ Cost Analysis (EE/CA) submitted for Public Comment – Late April 2004
  - Remedial Actions – Summer 2004
- **Real Estate Disposal**
  - Public Comment on Draft Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST) – Fall 2004
  - Public Sale – Winter 2004/2005



## Investigative Actions – Completed October 2003

- **Inside the Complex**
  - Removed & disposed of asbestos in entry tunnel
  - Verified by inspection no remaining transformers in facility
  - Re-sampled the water in missile silos for Gross Beta and speciation
- **Outside the Complex**
  - Installed and sampled three monitoring wells
  - Conducted a survey for a potential third water well
  - Placed soil borings around the Quonset Hut Area to determine lateral and vertical extent of total petroleum hydrocarbon (TPH) and semi volatile organic contamination (SVOCs) contamination
  - Identified location of former waste clarifier
  - Conducted additional onsite and background sampling for thallium
