No Further Response Action Titan I, Missile Site 1, Complex 1A Arapahoe County, Colorado

Environmental remediation work has been completed at the Titan I, Missile Site 1, Complex 1A, located on the former Lowry Bombing & Gunnery Range in Arapahoe County, Colorado.

Water in Missile Silo 1, identified as a potential future concern in the Site Investigation (SI), has been removed and properly disposed. The soil in the north sewage lagoon, identified as contaminated with Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs), has also been removed and properly disposed. The additional concern regarding the vent shafts has been addressed by placing plastic covers over the openings and anchoring them to the shaft structures.

Removal activities were completed in compliance with applicable or relevant and appropriate requirements (ARARs) by RMC Consultants, Inc., under contract with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, under the Department of Defense Environmental Restoration Program for Formerly Used Defense Sites (DERP-FUDS). The Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8, concur with the closure request for this site and agree that the former Lowry Titan I, Complex 1A, does not require any further environmental investigation or remedial action.

Based on the activities completed as part of the removal action and the subsequent conclusions, no hazardous materials exist on the property at this time and the site is available for unlimited use and unrestricted exposure.
